Summer Application/Reapplication Process

- Applications for Continued Access, a.k.a. Reapplications, are due May 1st. In addition to turning in your reapplication on time, you also need to complete and turn in the self-evaluation form by May 1st to be approved for the Summer Term. (Evaluation forms and a cd with one of your shows to evaluate was put in your folder April 6th.)
- The programming committee reviews all applications for continued access (reapplications) along side new program applications. We will announce our finalized schedule at the end of May 2008. You will be contacted by your day-captain should there be any changes in your show's placement that you need to know about.
- The programming schedule that we create for each term is based on the relevancy of programs to the Berkshire Community Radio Alliance mission, the availability of programmers and our programming goals. Though turning in an self-evaluation form is required to continue your show this summer term, the results of your evaluation will not change the outcome of the programming committee's scheduling process.
- WBCR-LP's summer term runs from June 1st-Sept 30th. Reapplications will be due for the fall term, Sept 1st unless otherwise announced.

Completed applications can be submitted to the programming committee by mailing (attn: Ananda Timpane) or dropping off your application at the studio. (Look for a large envelope by the mantle.)
